

Guru Nanak Dev University Signs MoU with Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Ropar

The Guru Nanak Dev University has taken a significant step toward fostering innovation and entrepreneurship by signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Ropar's Technology and Innovation Foundation.
