INSTRUCTIONS/GUIDELINES FOR THE CANDIDATES FOR TEST FOR THE POST OF JUNIOR TECHNICIAN, ELECTRONICS TECHNOLOGY

Note: As per Notification No. G.S.R. 72/Const./Art.309/Amd.(22)/2022 dated 28.10.2022 containing amendment issued by the Govt. of Punjab Personnel Deptt. titled as The Punjab Civil Services (General & Common Conditions of Service) (First amendment) Rules, 2022, qualifying test of Punjabi language equivalent to matriculation standard shall be conducted in addition to competitive examination. The candidates will be required to secure atleast 50% marks to qualify the Punjabi language test. Qualifying in this exam would be mandatory, however, the marks secured in this examination will not be counted for preparation of final merit. Failure to secure a minimum of 50% marks in Punjabi language examination will disqualify the candidate for further test. Theory - 70 marks (minimum qualifying marks 35)

Practical - 30 marks

- 1. There will be a written test comprising 70 marks.
- 2. The paper will consist of 35 objective type questions with multiple-choice each having two marks. There shall be no negative marking.
- 3. To qualify in written & practical test, the candidate will have to secure at least 50% marks separately each in Theory & Practical Test. However, merit list will be prepared on the basis of the marks to be obtained by the candidate in theory & practical Test.
- 4. The paper will be set out of the syllabi prescribed for 10+2 of the relevant subject/subjects.
- 5 Practical Test will be based on different kinds of job requirement.
